## Recovery ACT Reporting New Feature Announcement

**Stimulus Projects for Recovery Act of 2009** have extensive employment and project tracking and reporting requirements. These reports are crucial elements in the ARRA requirements. This will be a burdensome task for contractors to collect, track and submit this data, and for the government agency to consolidate and submit all of the required documentation.

**Prime Contractors** will be responsible to collect the data from all subcontractors and create a single summary report to be submitted back to the project owner. **Project owners (Cities, Transit, Airports, etc.)** will then have the responsibility of collating all the prime contractor reports and creating a summary report in accordance with ARRA requirements.

The reports are due each month for the previous month's work, and all contractors must submit or the stimulus funds could be withdrawn. *This is a huge effort in time, man-power, and tracking for the project owner and prime contractor.* Monthly reports for workers on the job that are required include:

- Tracking of all employees on the project by trade and classification of work
- Tracking of all dollars paid to all workers, breaking out new hires
- Tracking of all hours worked
- Tracking of new hires
- Tracking of all re-trained employees
- Tracking of prevailing wage and non-prevailing wage workers
