



According to the ***American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009*** , all laborers employed by contractors and subcontractors working on stimulus projects related to this Act, must be paid prevailing wages.

SEC. 1606. Notwithstanding any other provision of law and in a manner consistent with other provisions in this Act, all laborers and mechanics employed by contractors and subcontractors on projects funded directly by or assisted in whole or in part by and through the Federal Government pursuant to this Act shall be paid wages at rates not less than those prevailing on projects of a character similar in the locality as determined by the Secretary of Labor in accordance with subchapter IV of chapter 31 of title 40, United States Code

Additionally, recipients of federal stimulus funds are required to report on job creation and job retainage through the life of these projects.

SEC. 1512. REPORTS ON USE OF FUNDS

(c) RECIPIENT REPORTS.—Not later than 10 days after the end of each calendar quarter, each recipient that received recovery funds from a Federal agency shall submit a report to that agency that contains...**(3)**... **(D)** an estimate of the number of jobs created and the number of jobs retained by the project or activity;
